\*\*\* 2 Removes' is Farrier terminology for taking off a horses shoe, Traveler in this case, in order to dress the hoof and replace the shoe in a proper manner on the same or another foot, hence an old shoe used over again. \*\*This probably what he means on the 8th 'Blacksmith move 4 shoes'
