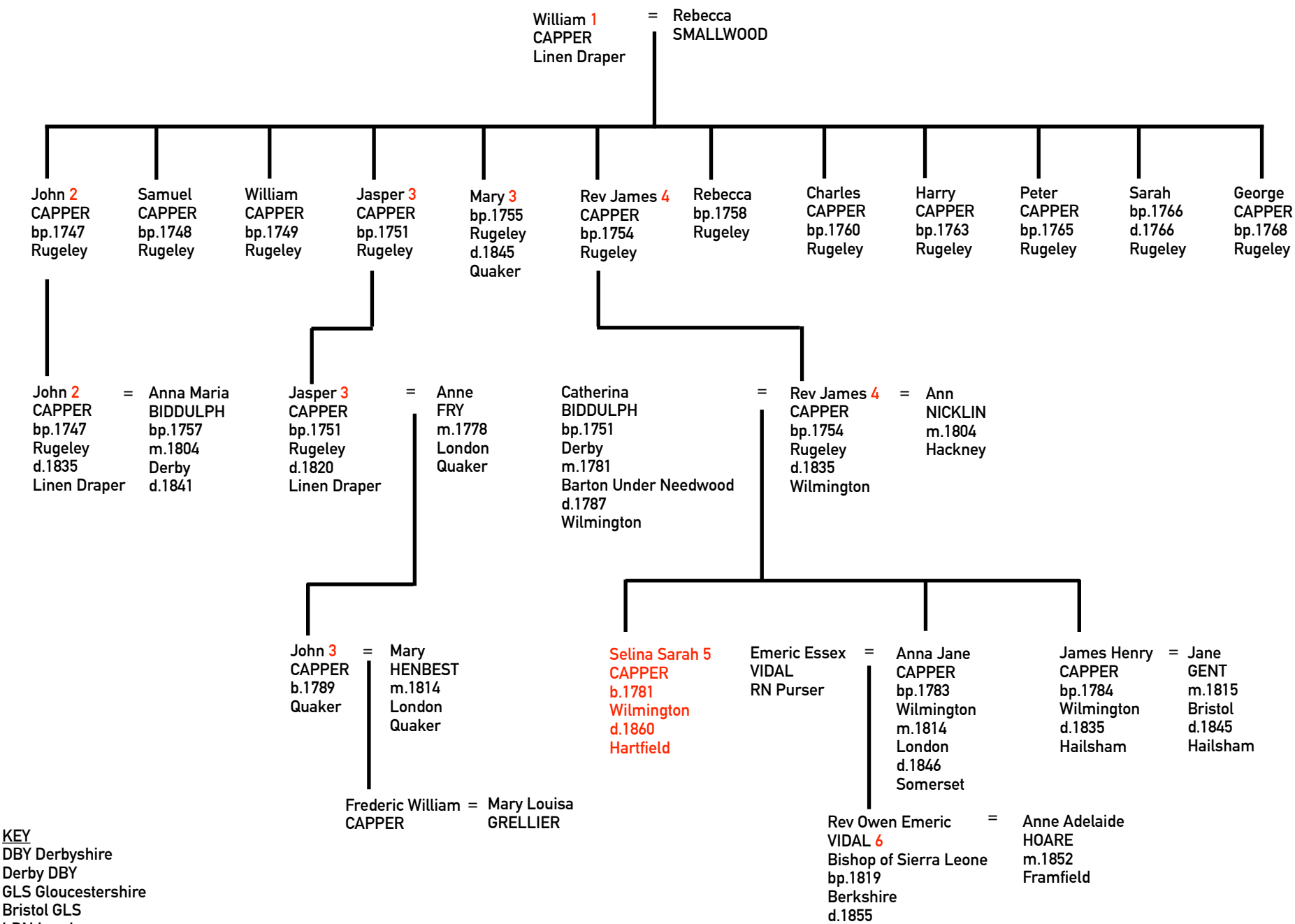


CAPPER Family Tree Page 1 of 3



1 William CAPPER was a mercer of Birmingham, and he was declared a bankrupt.

2 John CAPPER was a widower when he married Anna Maria BIDDULPH on the 3rd Jan 1804.
Anna Maria (bp.BIDDORPH sic) was the sister of Catherina BIDDULPH and Susannah BIDDULPH (Miss Susan in Mary's memoir **3**).

3 Jasper, his wife Ann, son John and John's wife Mary were Quakers.
Jasper's sister Mary CAPPER was a Quaker Minister and was a great influence on him, but not brother James.
Mary wrote a diary edited by Katherine BACKHOUSE (a daughter of Jasper CAPPER).
Mary wrote an account in her memoir of her visit to her brother, the Rev James CAPPER in Wilmington.
Mary's diary also transcripts of letters from her parents William and Rebecca, describing her relationship with them and her siblings.

4 The Rev James CAPPER was rector of Wilmington SSX for 56 years.
A memorial slab is in Wilmington church.

5 Selina Sarah CAPPER was companion to Lady SOBER (Ann KEMP) in Warbleton, Sussex.
Selina Sarah CAPPER was a witness at her father's second marriage to Ann NICKLIN in 1804.

6 The Rev Owen and his wife Ann Adelaide had a daughter Annie Selina Hoare VIDAL.
Annie Selina and her parents were named in the deeds of the Estate of Caleb DIPLOCK of Southdown Hall, Polegate.
